

Rules of Conduct For Albion Fish & Game Club

1. Each member shall be responsible for cleaning, restoring or replacing any article or condition that has been devalued or abused by their actions.
2. Each member is responsible for the actions of their guests. Except for Club functions no guests are allowed without the presence of a host member. The host member must be a Regular Member in Good Standing. The Host Member is responsible for the actions of any and all of their guests as if they were his/her own.
3. Alteration, destruction or removal of Club property is forbidden without the express consent of two members of the Board of Directors and/or membership vote.
4. No trash or discarded items are to be left on the property. Material left in proper receptacles during the course of approved activities is a noted exception. (i.e. targets, spent hulls, brass, earplugs, etc) No perishable or food items shall be left in any receptacles.
5. The Club will not reimburse or compensate for any purchase, agreement, service or loss to any member or their guest without the approval by a majority of members in good standing at a regular business meeting.
6. The Clubhouse and grounds are not to be used as a base for commercial enterprise. Exceptions must have the pre-approval of the Board of Directors and/or membership vote.
7. Appropriate safety measures will be observed at all times.
8. Firearms, bows, or crossbows shall only be discharged on the designated ranges. Long range shooting, beyond 100 yards, is not permitted at any time. Rifle, pistol and archery ranges may only be used between 9:00 am and sunset. The trap field hours are between 9:00 am and sunset, or when sunset is prior to 8:30 pm, shooting trap under the lights is permitted until 8:30 pm. Club sanctioned trap events may shoot past 8:30 pm. Firearms, archery equipment or crossbows shall not be discharged when the clubhouse or grounds are reserved for non club events without prior approval of the Board of Directors and/or membership vote. It is the responsibility of the shooter to police all brass or hulls and to remove paper targets from the target boards. Receptacles for brass are provided at the ranges, hulls, targets and other “clean” trash may be placed in the barrels under the pavilion. No perishable or food items are to be left in these receptacles; you must take such items with you.
9. No one is permitted behind the range backstops without first posting signs on the gate, the trap scoring stand, archery field and both firearms range houses indicating the ranges are closed and people are behind the ranges. River access is not permitted through the club property, at any time, for any purpose.

10. Hunting or trapping is not permitted on the club grounds without prior permission and consent of the Board of Directors and/or membership vote. In the event permission to hunt or trap is granted, rule 9 shall be strictly adhered to.
11. Any member, guest or non-member that brings a pet or animal onto the club property is responsible and obligated to clean up after their pet or animal. Pet waste may be disposed of in the non used areas of the grounds, but may not be left in the high traffic or mowed areas. Pet waste may not be disposed of in any trash receptacle.
12. Any Non-Member that reserves the Club is bound by rules 1 through 11. Such persons are not granted any privileges of Club membership, and may not use any of the ranges for any shooting activities. All participants at a Non-Member function, including current members, are obligated in the same manner.
